Welcome to this week's symbolic exploration.

Each week within Learn the Language of Oracle Through Symbolism, we explore the deeper meanings, imagery and reflective wisdom hidden within the symbols that appear throughout oracle cards.

This space is not about memorising rigid meanings or needing to be psychic enough, it is about learning to:

- observe symbolism more deeply
- learning to trust your intuition and feelings
- understand how imagery changes meaning
- connect with your cards through reflection and symbolic language

THIS WEEK'S SYMBOL: The Owl.

The Owl has been a symbol for both wisdom and intellect for as long as we can remember, and is often used throughout oracle card imagery to offer messages for us to reflect upon.

The Owl can represent:

- Wisdom
- intuition
- Patience
- Awareness
- Subconscious
- Spiritual guidance

When an owl shows up on your oracle cards it is important to take notice on the following.

- The colour of the owl
- Is the owl sitting or flying?
- Does the owl have their eyes open or closed?
- The surrounding imagery of the card
- Your intuition and feelings. Take note of what emotions or feelings come to surface when you see an owl on a Oracle card.

Each symbol has a Shadow side which is important to also take into consideration when reading an Oracle card. The shadow aspects are brought to you by feeling triggered or defensive along with the imagery of the owl (if the owl is hidden or watching from within the darkness).

The shadow meanings of the owl can be:

- Isolation
- Emotional distance
- Over-observing without action
- Fear of hidden truths.



SYMBOL OBSERVATION PRACTICE

Take a moment to observe the owl imagery on the following cards pictured above. Let's break them down so that you can see how the owl and its different messages show up of different oracle cards and decks.

Please note: there is no right or wrong answer when it comes to reading oracle cards or symbolism, what I observe on each of the following cards could be very different to your perspective. This is because we view the cards from our own subconscious and energy.

Card 1: A simple owl sitting on a branch. At first we can take in that its a brown owl, brown symbolises grounding and stability which aligns with the branch. An owl perched on a tree can symbolise observation, stillness and patience, but also trust (all birds trust the branches to hold their weight). As the Owl is looking away what I am feeling is that this owl is little unsure, not feeling grounded nor safe and maybe scared and over-thinking (with the word thinking on the card) which direction to take or sacred to take action in life. The question it is reflecting to you is:: Why are you scared to take direction of your life?

Card 2: An owl in flight which can symbolise forward movement and freedom. Along with the owl, the next thing that stands out is the green of the card. Green symbolises growth, healing and heart-centred energy. The tree in the picture also can symbolise growth and renewal, the reflection of the tree in the calm water can symbolise steady emotions and clarity, along with the word wisdom. this card can say: What emotional healing do you need to take to free your heart for healing and growth?

Card 3: Along with wisdom, owls are known for helping us navigate through the darkness and the unknown because of their nocturnal nature. As shown in this card, the owl is sitting on the woman's shoulder as a guide. The owl is mostly white which can symbolise sacred protection, intuition, calmness and spiritual guidance. The woman is wearing black which can mean grief, shadow work and protection, because of the stormy seas behind her and she is walking towards us, it can mean she is overcoming emotional turmoil or with the two paths behind her maybe she felt that she lost her way and is now being led into the light and on the right path. It can you to explore: How can you navigate your way through emotional storms?

ORACLE CARD REFLECTION PRACTICE

Either with your own deck if it has a card with an owl on it or you can practice with Card 4. Take a moment to sit and reflect on what message the card wishes you to know. Remember, there is no right or wrong answer when reading oracle cards. This is where symbolic interpretation begins. Not through memorisation but through observation, feeling and reflection. (Hint: Full moon can symbolise reflection, intuition and emotions.)

REFLECTIVE JOURNAL PROMPTS

- What message does the owl have for me right now?
- Where am I being called to trust in my intuition?
- Am I called to sit and observe or take action ?

When the Owl appears repeatedly within oracle imagery, it often invites us to reconnect to the wisdom that we already have buried within us, to stop and observe with patience and trust, to not be afraid of the darkness and the unknown.

Obviously, this is just a small teaching of symbolism, for the language is vast and unlimited and can change depending on cards, your energy and what messages you need in the moment, allowing the cards to differ their meaning each time you see the same symbol.
